GENERAL ADMINISTRATIVE INFORMATION PERTAINING TO ENTRIES

Who may enter

- 1. This is a provincial event and only GKF-affiliated members may enter.
- **2.** All athletes must be medically fit before they can be allowed to participate. Any medical condition must be mentioned in the Indemnity with a doctor's clearance certificate.
- 3. The age cut-off date is 17th October 2025.
- **4.** It is the responsibility of every District Coaches, and or Dojo instructor's to explain the conditions and rules to each athlete and/or parent before entering the championship.

Entries and payments

- **5.** Entry fees must be deposited into the GKF account by Districts only. No payment will be accepted by individuals. Please use proper referencing when making deposits:

Closing date of entries

- 7. Closing date of entries is Wednesday, 22nd January 2025 @ 5pm.
- **8.** No late entries will be accepted. Districts must confirm with the GKF Secretary and GKF Treasurer prior to the closing date that entries have been received and verified.

Weigh in

- **9.** Weigh in will be conducted by the relevant district.
- **10.** Random weight checks will be carried out at the discretion of the appointed official at the GKF Championship.
- 11. NB! Should an athlete be found in his/her incorrect weight division then that athlete will be disqualified.
- **12.** Parents and Instructors must ensure that athletes are entered into the correct weight categories. This will be vigilantly monitored. It is not the responsibility of GKF and GKF cannot be held accountable for any disqualifications for incorrect information.

Amendments to entries

- **13.**Parents, Instructors, District Coaches and Team Managers must ensure that correct information is submitted with regards to athlete data i.e. date of birth, weight, indemnity, division, etc.
- **14.** Any changes to entries after the deadline date will be charged at a cost of **R500.00** per entry.

General championship rules

- **15.** An athlete participates at their own risk. No claims can be made against GKF or officials. A signed indemnity form must be filled out by a parent or guardian and kept with the district team manager.
- **16.** An athlete not reporting to his/her floor after 3-call outs will be disqualified.
- **17.**WKF rules will apply during the entire tournament and all equipment must be WKF approved. If athletes do not have the correct WKF equipment, the WKF rule will apply.
- 18.NB!! The draws will NOT have a seeding process.
- 19. The external protector is compulsory for under 14 categories
- **20.** All athletes that qualify for the GKF Training Squad will be expected to attend a minimum of 3 GKF training sessions during the year.

Gi's and protective gear

- 21. A plain white kata and kumite gi will be allowed as well as the premier red and blue karate suits.
- **22.** Cadets, juniors, u/21, seniors, veterans and masters need all WKF protective gear as per WKF rules. (<u>This is for Elite Athletes Only</u>)
- **23.** Children 6 to 13 need gum guards and a pair of blue and red mitts minimum, but will be advised to purchase WKF approved equipment as they will need it for KSA. competitions
- **24.** No national or provincial apparel will be permitted in the competition venue, including but not limited to t-shirts, tracksuits, shorts, hoodies, and caps. You are here to represent your District. Wear only district or plain apparel.

Coaches

- 25. Coaches from each district will need to attend the coaches briefing.
- **26.** All Districts must ensure that their coaches are accredited in the district.
- 27. WKF rules on coaching must be adhered to.
- 28.4 Elite coaches per district will be allowed to coach the district team at provincial level.
- 29. Each district must have 2 development coaches.

Team Manager

- **30.**The District Team Managers must wear their official attire (Navy blue blazer, white shirt, tie, grey pants, black shoes & socks).
- **31.** District Team Managers are not allowed in competition area.

Referees and Judges

- **32.** All officials must be dressed appropriately as per WKF rules (Navy blue blazer, white shirt, tie, grey pants, black shoes & socks)
- **33.**WKF rules apply during the entire tournament.
- 34. Each district must provide officials (referees and judges)

Table Officials

- 35. All officials must be dressed appropriately (White shirt, black pants, black shoes & socks)
- **36.** Each district must provide 2 table officials.

KATA RULES

Children 7-9 years	Need to do 2 katas. One must be repeated till medal round when 2 nd kata must be performed.
Children 10 – 11 years	Need to do 3 katas. First 2 can be repeated if more than 2 rounds till medal round when the 3 rd one must be performed.
Children 12 to 13 years	Need to do 4 katas. First 3 can be repeated alternatively till medal round when 4 th kata must be performed.
Cadets	Must be able to perform 5 katas not repeating a kata in any round.
Juniors	Must be able to perform 5 katas not repeating a kata in any round.
Under 21, seniors, veterans and masters	Must be able to perform 5 katas not repeating a kata in any round
Team Kata	As for individual kata but from 14 and above must be able to perform bunkai in medal round.
